ISJ Paper Development Workshop at **2nd India Conference on Information Systems (InCIS)**

The Information Systems Journal (ISJ) is pleased to announce its paper development workshop (PDW) at **InCIS2026**.

Interested authors are invited to submit their working / full papers for possible inclusion in the PDW. Submitted papers should not be under review anywhere. We plan to accept a few papers that are of high quality and/or have the potential to develop into high-quality submissions targeted toward the leading journals of Information Systems (IS). Please note that not all submissions received by us can be accepted for discussion in the PDW. Papers that are not accepted will not receive feedback.

Submissions can be on any topic related to Information Systems and may use any research methodology (qualitative, quantitative, design, mixed-methods, etc.).

The selected papers will be mentored by two senior editors of the ISJ Editorial Board. Please note that the workshop is not associated with any publication. The goal is to offer feedback to the authors that can help enhance the quality of the paper as it is prepared for submission to a suitable journal of their choice. Authors do not have an obligation to submit the paper to ISJ just because it has been accepted and discussed in the ISJ PDW at InCIS 2026. Also, please note that participation in the workshop does not imply a favourable consideration or outcome at ISJ.

The length of the working papers submitted to the workshop should not exceed 10 pages (double-spaced, 12 font) – this includes everything, including references. The first page (not counted in the 10 pages) must have the title of the paper, the name(s), affiliation(s), and email address(es) of the author(s), and 3-5 keywords.

The link will accept your ISJ PDW submissions from 15th October to 15th November 2025. Papers submitted outside this window will not be considered for review. The decision about the inclusion of your submission will be communicated by 10th December 2025. A few accepted papers from other tracks of InCIS 2026 may also be invited to this workshop as per the recommendations of their respective track chairs.
